- contribute to work on drivers of change
- contribute to SOER (EEA 2025)
- feed into FORENV process
- illustrate and understand where «transformation» is already happening
- track positive signals

- by monitoring societal debate on social media
- experimental approach / mutual learning process

Idea: Identifying emerging issues with positive &/or negative impact on the environment

Next planned activities:

- Q4 2020: FLIS-contribution to FORENV (DG ENV/EKC process)
- Q1 2023: FLIS-contribution to SOER 2025

Current state of work: on hold

→ Idea: Ongoing selection of interesting weak signals (back2back with Green Shift project)

Guiding Question No. 1: The New Normal?

How does COVID change our societies and how do these changes impact the environment?

We collect everything related to COVID and the enviroment from all possible (online) sources.



Guiding Question No. 2: A Green Shift?

Can we observe a bottom-up «Green Shift» in European societies?

Signs of emerging issues related to a "Green Shift" in Society e.g. bottom-up sustainability initiatives, niche innovations and to other issues with impact on the environment e.g. in food, housing, mobility, energy, and other issues.



Guiding Question No. 3: News from the Horizon?

What is going on that could be a hint for a new mega topic and might be important for FLIS-members to know?

We identify all signals, which might have

- a) a significant impact on the environment (positive, negative, direct or indirect) and
- b) aren 't on the polical/research agenda yet



What we have done so far...

2 Cycles of Collection

- Pearltrees (a collective Pinboard)
- Any language is fine (Title in English)
- Any source is fine don 't forget **social media!**

2 Newsletters published!

- email newsletter (once every 4 to 6 weeks)
- continuous sense-making
- refine the research questions
